
- Population: 1,090,907 (May 2000 census)

- Albay was identified as a typhoon-prone and a flood-prone area by the National Disaster Coordinating Council
- Albay was highly devastated by Typhoons Milenyo and Reming in 2006





#### Polangu

- Population of 77 122 people in 13,773 households
- Subdivided into 44 barangays
- It has inland rivers and creeks that are highly prone to floods
