

TYPHOON LAWIN (HAIMA)

Situation Report #2

18 October 2016, Tuesday, 6pm

Overall Situation

- Typhoon Haima is expected to make landfall over Cagayan Area by Thursday early morning (Oct. 20) then will cross Apayao and Ilocos Norte
- It could make landfall with wind gusts over 275 km/h (173 mph), causing major damage to areas in its path. Winds of this magnitude are capable of major structural damage, including completely removing exterior walls and roofs.
- The extremely strong winds in combination with the torrential rains will down trees and may cause widespread power outages that could linger even after the storm has passed.

Emergency Response Efforts

- Alert for Typhoon Haima was sent to the following Regional Centers in Central and Northern Luzon:
 - Alay Bayan-Luson, Inc. (ABI)

- Cagayan Valley Disaster Response Center (CVDRC)
- Ilocos Center for Research, Empowerment and Development (ICRED)
- Cordillera Disaster Response and Development Services (CordisRDS)
- The Regional Centers have alerted their respective areas/communities to prepare or to organize pre-emptive evacuation
- CDRC Emergency Protocol Structure remains operational and is closely monitoring the situation and gathering information from the Regional Centers and other partners
- At 5pm, volunteers finished repacking prepositioned goods at the CDRC warehouse

- Prepositioned goods available at the CDRC warehouse in Quezon City:
 - 250 food packs containing:
 - 10 kg rice
 - 1 kg dried fish
 - 6 cans sardines
 - ½ liter cooking oil
 - Tarpaulin:
 - 55 pcs tarpaulin roof
 - Sleeping kits:
 - 1,500 pcs mat
 - 1,500 pcs blanket
 - 100 pcs collapsible water container
 - 295 pcs bath soap
- Donations from private individuals
 - 72 bottles mineral water
 - 72 packs noodles
 - 5 bags clothes
 - 3 boxes assorted relief goods
