

## TYPHOON LAWIN (HAIMA)

Situation Report #4

20 October 2016, Thursday, 6:30pm

### Overall Situation

- At 11:00 PM on 19 October, STY #LawinPH (international name: Haima) has made landfall over Baguio Pt., Peñablanca, Cagayan
- With maximum sustained winds of up to 225 kph and gustiness of up to 315 kph, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) #5 was raised in Cagayan and Isabela and TCWS #4 in Apayao, Kalinga, Ilocos Norte, Abra, Ilocos Sur, Mt. Province, Ifugao and Calayan Group of Islands
- At 5:00 AM today, state weather bureau PAGASA said Lawin has weakened into a typhoon (top winds weakened to 205 kph while its gusts went down to 285 kph) as it traversed Apayao province. However, continued to unleash devastating winds and intense rains.
- At 5:00 PM today, Lawin exited PAR
- TCWS are now lifted

#### Reports on Affected Population (NDRRMC data)

- A total of 18,157 families or 90,589 individuals were pre-emptively evacuated in the Ilocos, Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon, Bicol, CALABARZON and Cordillera Administrative Regions
  - As of 11 am today, Santa, Ilocos Sur MDRRMC declared all public buildings full and arrival of evacuees from other barangays still on-going
- On 19-21 Oct, class suspensions were declared in different areas in Regions 1, 2, 3, CALABARZON, MIMAROP, 5 and CAR
- On 18-21 Oct, work suspensions were also declared in government offices and private establishments in various provinces in Ilocos region and CAR
- Six (6) road sections In Regions 3 and CAR reported not passable due to flooding and slides
  - According to Office of Civil Defense (OCD) CAR, 37 national, provincial and municipal road networks are not passable due to road blocks caused by fallen posts, landslides, roadslips and debris
- A total of 3,544 passengers, 329 rolling cargoes, 33 vessels and 79 motor bancas were reported stranded in various ports in Southern Tagalog, Western Visayas, Bicol, and Northeastern Luzon
- Power interruptions were experienced in different areas in Region 1 and CALABARZON
  - Oct 19 afternoon, region-wide power outage in CAR
- Cellular network signal interruptions are experienced in Quezon, various provinces in CAR and Cagayan Valley
- Fourteen (14) domestic flights were cancelled
- Chico, Apayao, Abra and Cagayan rivers are in critical level
- Due to incidents of blown roofs, fallen trees, flash flooding in lower areas and landslides, road and runway clearings for relief operations are urgently needed.

#### Emergency Response Efforts

- Oct 17, alert for Typhoon Haima was sent to the following Regional Centers in Central and Northern Luzon:
  - Alay Bayan-Luson, Inc. (ABI)
  - Cagayan Valley Disaster Response Center (CVDRC)
  - Ilocos Center for Research, Empowerment and Development (ICRED)
  - Cordillera Disaster Response and Development Services (CordisRDS)
- The Regional Centers have alerted their respective areas/communities to prepare or to organize pre-emptive evacuation
- CDRC Emergency Protocol Structure remains operational and is closely monitoring the situation and gathering information from the Regional Centers and other partners
- At 5pm Oct 18, volunteers finished repacking prepositioned goods at the CDRC warehouse
- At 2pm Oct 19, ABI's La Union team currently with Disaster Preparedness Committees (DPCs) reviewed Counter Disaster Plans and conducted

simultaneous preemptive evacuation warning after the 2pm PAGASA bulletin was issued.

- ABI's Nueva Ecija Team and Aurora Team are still in the areas.
- At 6pm Oct 19, CDRC deployed staff for Rapid Needs Analysis and initial relief to Cagayan and Isabela

      - 10 pcs toothbrush
      - 12 sachets conditioner
      - 2 dozens sachets shampoo
      - 5 rolls tissue
      - 2 dozens sachet toothpaste
      - 10 packs sanitary napkins
      - 6 boxes mosquito coils
  - Oct 21, Friday (Donor: CARE; Partner: CVDRC)
    - Where:
      - Brgy. Gabut, Amulong, Cagayan
      - Brgy. Dafunganay, Amunlong, Cagayan
    - What:
      - 250 packs containing:
        - 5 kg rice

        - 250 g coffee
        - 1/4 kg sugar
        - 1/4 kg dried fish
  - Oct 22, Saturday (Donor: Mercy Relief; Partner: CVDRC)
