


Typhoon Nina (Nock-Ten) Situation Report #1 23 December 2016, Wednesday, 10am

Overall Situation

- Severe Tropical Storm (STS) Nock-Ten has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was named Nina.
- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy rains within its 350 km diameter of the severe tropical storm.
- As of 4am, it is located 960 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar and forecasted to move west Northwest at 25 kph.
- It is packing maximum sustained winds of up to **95 kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **120 kph**.
- No tropical cyclone warning signal.
